In order to meet the requirements for recertification, a CTRS[®] must choose **one of the following two options:**

OPTION 1

Work Experience and Continuing Education:

- 480 hours of professional work experience in the field of therapeutic recreation **and...**
- 50 hours of continuing education related to the NCTRC Job Analysis Knowledge Areas

OPTION 2

Pass the NCTRC Certification Exam:

- Submit the Exam Registration Form
(Contact the NCTRC office to discuss which exam cycle corresponds with your recertification date.)

Login to your NCTRC account for applications and payment options.

Recertify and continue to possess the most well-recognized credential within the therapeutic recreation profession.
